The Disabilities Resource Centre (DRC) Southland – is a Total Mobility/Ridewise agency for Invercargill. The Invercargill City Council (ICC) administers and monitors the scheme in Southland on behalf of the New Zealand Transport Authority (NZTA). There are more than 1200 registered Total Mobility users in Southland.

DRC conduct assessments at their Gala Street premises. The assessments, which are confidential, are usually completed within 15 minutes. DRC staff will also take your photo which will be printed on your Total Mobility card. It is important you make an appointment with an assessor.
